SAFETY LIAISON: The Safety Chair will serve as a neighborhood liaison to the Baltimore City Police Department and the Baltimore City Fire Department. The outgoing Safety Chair will inform the incoming chair of all contact information to ensure a smooth transition.

COMMUNITY SAFETY: The Safety Chair, working with any appropriate board members, will coordinate community safety through a variety of means. These means may include, but are not limited to, Neighborhood Safety Walks, Safety Events (e.g., Lights On events to remind neighbors to turn on porch lights in the evening), notifications of any active or recent safety events using appropriate communication channels.

SPECIAL PROJECT: Select and execute a special project in each year. Working with the President, the Safety Chair will select a special project to be conducted during the year that will improve the safety of the neighborhood. Examples of special projects in the past that should be repeated on an annual basis include Safety Walks (identify safety concerns, such as overgrown bushes or ladders against houses).

AN ACTIVE VOLUNTEER: Be ready to do a lot of jack of all trades stuff as you do not have extensive formal duties. You should be very willing to undertake many various tasks.
